### Waivers and Conditions

1. The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper who is a hazard to the safety and rights of others, or who appears to have rejected the reasonable controls of the camp. The parent/guardian certifies that the applicant is normal in condition and habits and is amenable to necessary discipline. Failure to disclose problems at time of application could result in dismissal.

2. The parents/guardians submitting this application are those who have legal custody over the child. Conditions of custody, if applicable, will be fully communicated in writing to the camp, including a photocopy of the section of any court order referring to visitation rights.

3. I, the parent or guardian of the named participant, release Nemeiben Lake Canoe and Bible Camp, its directors, staff and agents from any loss, personal injury, accident, misfortune or damage to the above-named or his/her/my property, with understanding that reasonable precautions shall be taken to ensure the health and safety of the named participant.

4. I/We acknowledge and accept and agree that attendance at Nemeiben Lake Canoe and Bible Camp involves inherent risks due to its wilderness setting and characteristics.

5. The signature of the parent/guardian on the application shall give the Camp Director the right to arrange for any special services or other requirements necessary for the best interest of the camper/applicant and shall give the Camp Director the right to approve and obtain medical attention necessary for the camper's welfare and good health including injection, anesthesia or surgery. In such situations the camp will attempt to notify, the parents/guardians/emergency contact on registration application, as soon as possible. The parent/guardian/adult camper is responsible for any additional expenses that may result from such services.

6. We agree to permit reasonable use of photos and videos in promoting the camp.

The Nemeiben Lake Canoe and Bible Camp is a wilderness camp. It is situated on a peninsula of Canadian Shield, approximately 8 miles from the public dock in Bell Bay on Nemeiben Lake. The camp has no direct road access and can only be reached by boat which depending on weather conditions can vary from 20 to 45 minutes.

Buildings at the camp consist of two lodges. The original lodge is a wooden structure with attached dining hall, kitchen, and two separate dorm rooms providing the sleeping quarters. A new lodge also provides additional sleeping quarters and lounge area. Solar power provides limited electricity for lighting, along with wood burning stoves providing warmth. Water for drinking is either bottled or filtered to safe guidelines. Washroom facilities consist of pit toilets, along with a wash up area beneath an attached shelter. There are no shower facilities. Campers will be asked to help with various tasks (dishes, clean up, etc.).

### Refund Policy

Camp fees are not refundable if cancellation is made less than 30 days before camp. In case of withdrawal from camp on Physicians orders, refund will be made for the entire camp fees. No refund will be made for late arrivals, early departures or dismissals due to disciplinary action.
